The scientific committee cordially invites you to submit your abstracts for oral presentations or posters.

Authors are kindly invited to submit their abstracts on this website **only**. Listed below are the instructions for abstract submissions. Abstracts submitted by fax or e-mail will not be accepted.

Submission guidelines

1. Abstracts can be submitted for the following categories:
 - Basic Immunology
 - Clinical Immunology
 - Allergology
 - Translational science
2. You indicate the desired presentation format upon submission:
 - Poster
 - Oral presentation
3. You indicate whether their abstract is supported by the industry upon submission.
4. The presenter must be an independent investigator or practicing physician listed in the abstract author string. An author employed by a company (including pharmaceutical, diagnostic, data or AI companies) cannot act as the presenter or corresponding author of any work related to clinical or translational data, defined as data/parameters captured in interventional clinical studies (phase I-IV) and observational or real-world data series, involving patients. Authors employed by a company are allowed to present preclinical data.
5. Abstracts need to be submitted and presented in English.
6. Please pay attention to correct spelling, as there will be no subsequent proof-reading/corrections. The abstract will be published exactly as submitted.



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7. The abstract text body is limited to 1600 characters (including spaces).
8. The abstract should be presented in such a way that the scientific committee can assess its significance and contribution to advance knowledge. The abstract text should state briefly:
 - Brief introduction and aim of the study
 - Design & methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
9. Standard abbreviations are accepted in the text. Unusual abbreviations must be explained in brackets when the word first appears. Do not use abbreviations in the title.
10. The presenting author is requested to provide his full mailing address (including e-mail address) for all correspondence.
11. Submitted abstracts will be evaluated and selected by the scientific committee for contribution.
12. The scientific committee will allocate selected abstracts for either oral communication or presentation as a poster.
13. The decision of the scientific committee regarding the admission of the abstract will be communicated to the authors by mid-June 2025. Organizational details will reach the authors in due course.
14. Authors, whose abstracts are accepted for presentation, must register for the congress and pay the registration fee.
